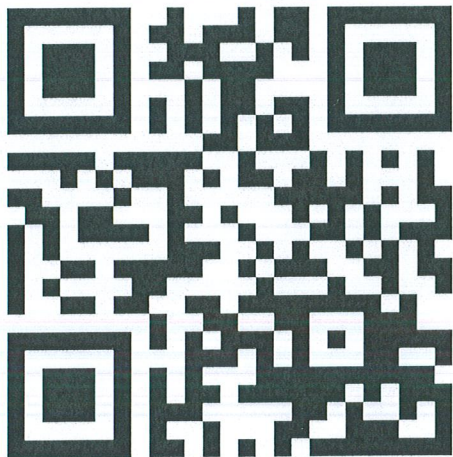

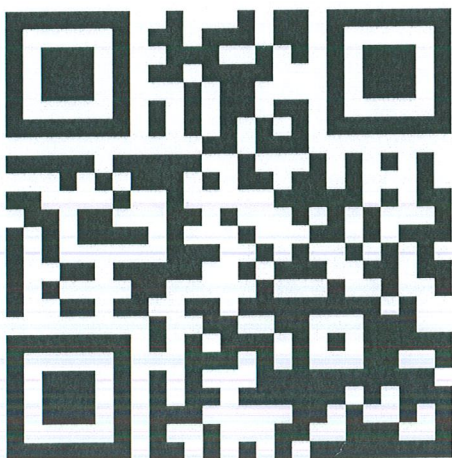

Dear Mr. Tremblay:

The Living Income Benefit you currently receive includes funds for clothing. Special clothing such as incontinence supplies or due to rapid weight gain or loss of 25 pounds or more can be prescribed by a physician. The prescription you provided from Dr. Sanderson does not qualify for this grant.

If you wish however, you could request a Household Advance to meet this need. Advances are recovered from your monthly benefits at the rate of \$40.00/month until recovered in full. You may not take another advance while one is outstanding. Advances can be issued up to \$240.00. This would take 6 months to be recovered before a further advance could be requested. Attached is the form, should you decide to take this advance.

Should you disagree with the decision concerning your current application, you have the right to appeal. Your request for appeal must be received within 30 days from the date of this letter. To appeal, state your concerns in writing to the Unit Administrator at the above address. Senior officials will review your case. If no change is possible, a hearing will be set before a committee outside the Ministry. You can present your concerns at the hearing.

Interim benefits may be available until your appeal hearing. If you need interim benefits, please request this in your letter. Expenses for child care and travel to attend an appeal hearing outside your community may also be available.
