Dear Mr. Tremblay:

Thank you for your November 2, 2012 letter regarding your request for an appeal.

Unfortunately, there is no decision in my letter dated October 29, 2012 of which to appeal. My letter was an explanation to you regarding your letter dated October 24, 2012, in which you stated that you were denied the entitlement of the Saskatchewan Rental Housing Supplement for the months of June, July and August. You were not denied these monies. You received \$179 from the Saskatchewan Rental Housing Supplement for each of the mentioned months. You also received \$150 excess shelter for these months. You are correct that under the Saskatchewan Assured Income for Disabilities program the excess shelter is not reduced by an amount up to, or equal to, the Saskatchewan Rental Housing Supplement. Your excess shelter was not reduced. You were entitled to \$150, which you received for each month. You were entitled to \$179 from the Saskatchewan Rental Housing Supplement, which you also received for each month.

You were not entitled to have your full rent paid under the communities with vacancy rates less than 1.5% clause for the months of June, July and August because you did not submit a notice of rent increase that came into effect on June 1, 2012. Your notice of rent increase stated that your rental increase would take effect September 1, 2012. Since this date, your full rent has been paid under this clause because the vacancy rate in Moose Jaw is less than 1.5%.

As there was no decision in my letter for you to appeal, your request will not be forwarded to the Regional Appeal Committee.

Thank you for sharing your concerns.
